The biggest change is guilf. If you die, they send you to gulag once for a one-on-one showdown. If you win, you reschedule for free, and if you lose, your teammates will have to buy you back. This mechanic removes all the bad moments from Warzone, where you happen to fall into the free-prey zone and someone kills you before you can get your bearings. PUBG Mobile Xbox One and PC versions of PlayerUnknown's Battlegrounds are not free-to-play, but if you want to enjoy some strategic battle royale campaigns along the way and are not in the mood for Fortnite, PUBG Mobile is a great alternative. The game is based on a version of your computer and includes touch controls so you can still aim down your weapons sights, loot buildings, drive across a huge map of the game, and punch people with frying pans. For long-distance running, simple virtual lock bars you basically set and forget, and there's even voice chat support Your team-based games so you can coordinate with your teammates before going in to kill you. Pubg Mobile isn't hasty, too. The game has been optimized for mobile devices, running on framrate, which can often put the Xbox One version to shame. Depending on the device - the iPhone 6s is the oldest supported phone - the game automatically selects the graphics settings, but you can change them at any time to increase details or improve performance. Fortnite: Battle Royale on the footstep of PlayerUnknown's Battlegrounds comes Fortnite: Battle Royale, a free-player-versus-player piece of the game's epic zombie defense shooter. Yet PUBG, the goal in Fortnite: Battle Royale is to get off all the other players in the game and be the last standing. But Fortnite's cartoon attack on the mechanics of shooting means you get an alternative to PUBG's more militaristic (and slightly more realistic) shooter.
